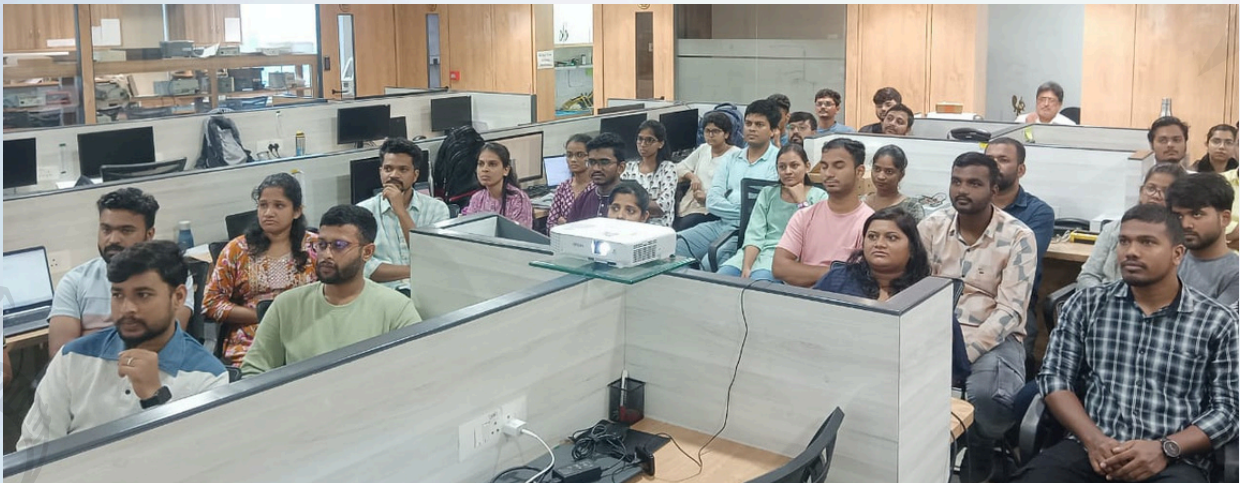

Platforms influence opportunity.

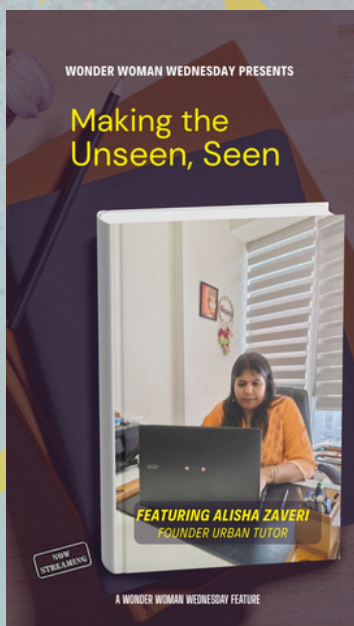
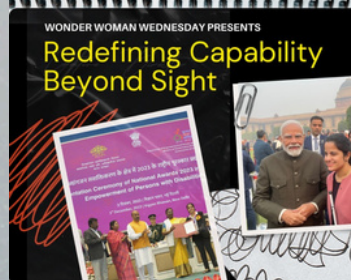
Artificial intelligence shapes information.

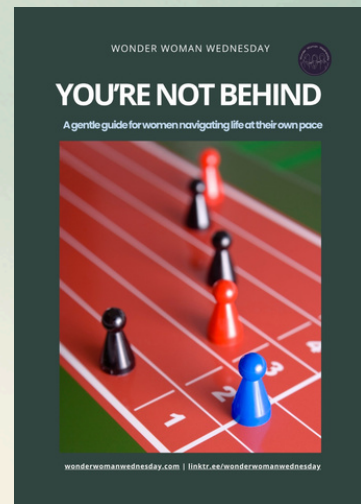
